He said their would be a joint effort to

clean the rivers and improve water quality. "It is estimated that 170 toppes of publish enter the Klang river every year but only 25 tomies are cleared.

age entering the river every day," he said. Najib said strict enforcement and a change of mandast were needed to ensure the rivers were kept clean.

The project, he said, had huge economic potential, would attract more tourists, create jobs as well as raise property value along the Klang and Gombak rivers.

Najih said the project was expected to con-tribute. RM11.3bil. to the country's Gross

Domestic Product until 2020, The project is disided into those parts. namely river cleaning, which will involve a 110km stretch along the Klang river basis; river beautification along a 10.7km stretch by the Klang and Gorebak river corridor which will include pedestriats walkways: and corridor development.

Najib also viewed the five masterplas pro-posals for the river beautification master

planning competition.

Later, at the launch of the Kuala Lumpur Architecture Festival, be said a new afforda-ble home scheme for low and middle-income earners would be bonched on Monday.
